

Camping Checklist



ALL CLEARLY LABELLED WITH THE CUB'S NAME

BEDDING

- Sleeping pad, mats, air mattress, air pump
- Sleeping Bag
- Extra Blanket (for cold weather)
- One Cuddly Toy/ Comforter
- Pillows

TOILETRY BAG

- Tooth Brush
- Toothpaste
- Brush or Comb
- Soap in a container/Ziplock Bag
- Face Washer
- Roll on Deodorant
- All in a Toiletry bag
- Towel
- Thongs (to wear to/from/in shower only)!

DAY PACK

- A small backpack to take along to activities
- Personal First Aid Kit
- Water Bottle
- Sunscreen (in Zip lock Bag)
- Insect Repellent (not Aerosol)
- Plastic Bag (to Line the Day Pack)
- Asthma Medication

MESS KIT

- Dinner Plate, Cereal Bowl
- Mug
- Knife, Fork and Spoon
- Tea Towel
- All in a Drawstring bag

Clothing and laundry

- Cub Uniform & Scarf (wear to and from Camp – Make sure it is Labelled)
- 2 Shorts
- 2 Long Trousers
- 2 T-Shirts (No Crop tops or singlets)
- 1 Long Sleeved T-Shirts/shirt
- 1 Warm Jumper/Jacket
- 2 Pairs of Closed shoes in case one gets wet
- Underwear
- Socks (always good to throw in a spare pair)
- Handkerchiefs/tissues
- Pajamas/tracksuit to keep you warm at night
- Raincoat
- Fully brimmed hat (NO HAT means NO ACTIVITIES)
- Towel
- Torch (with spare batteries)
- Plastic bags for wet/dirty gear

Swimming/Water Sports

- Swimmers inc Rash vest
- Swim Towel
- Fully Enclosed Shoes to Get wet

First aid & hygiene

- Any required medication –
Place in a zip lock bag and place your name on the outside. Please include medication instructions. Please also complete the asthma/allergy plan if your child suffers from these. This form is available from your Leaders.

DO NOT BRING

No lollies/chips/soft drink. No mobile phones, electronic games, tablet, or any form of electronic gadget/computer. No aerosols (including insect repellent) are to be brought to camp.
